David's 2024 Summary of Bicycle Facility Construction in Springfield Area -

Completed Construction

- The Chadwick Flyer Trail Phase 3 from the Greene/Christian County line to Kissick Road (4,200 feet).
- A **Galloway Trail Connector** to the intersection of Lone Pine Avenue and Battlefield Street between Half a Hill Shopping Center and the Lone Pine Recycling Center is complete.
- Sidewalks and Streetscape were completed on **Jefferson Avenue from Olive Street to Walnut Street** including a new traffic signal at St. Louis Street.
- On Grant Avenue between Catalpa Street and University Street adjacent to Parkview High school and
 Fassnight Park as a part of the Grant Avenue Parkway Project, the completed work includes a roundabout
 at Chrisman Drive for access to parking on each side of Grant Avenue, a sidepath for walking and bicycling,
 and burial of utility lines.
- **Fassnight Trail** in Phelps Grove Park between Clay Avenue and Brookside Drive including a new bridge at the Art Museum (0.32 miles).
- Bulb-outs at **South Avenue and Pershing Street**, **Jefferson Avenue and Elm Street**, **and Broadway Avenue and Mt. Vernon Street** to improve pedestrian visibility and reduce length of crossing.
- **Division Street** from Fremont Avenue to Glenstone Avenue was widened to three lanes with 10-foot sidepath on south side connecting to Jordan Creek Trail and sidewalk on north side.
- Chadwick Flyer Trail in Ozark from the Ozark Community Center to Clay Street (0.7 miles)
- A trail has been constructed in Ozark across the Finley River Bridge along McCracken Street and 3rd Street from Ozark Mill to Garrison Branch (0.2 mile)

Current Construction

- **Grant Avenue** between Sunshine Street and University Street includes construction of a walk/bike path, burial of utilities, and landscaping starting in December 2023.
- **Grant Avenue** between Catalpa Street and Walnut Street includes construction of a walk/bike path burial of utilities and landscaping.
- **Kansas Expressway** between Republic Road and Plainview Road including a 10-foot sidepath on one side is under construction through 2023.
- Republic Road between James River Freeway and Fairview Avenue including Campbell Avenue intersection is being widened to two through lanes east and west, double left turn lanes, right-turn slip lanes, bike lanes, sidewalks, and pedestrian signals. Bike lanes are to be extended from James River Freeway to Kansas Avenue between March and December 2023.
- A trail is being built along **Wilson's Creek Boulevard (MO Hwy ZZ)** from the new roundabout at FR 182 to Republic Road.

Funded Construction (construction within next year)

- **Finley Farms Connector Trail** (500 feet) in Ozark from Jackson Street bridge to new bridge at Finley Farms is funded.
- **Galloway Road** from Luster Avenue to Lone Pine Avenue is to be widened and levelled including two through lanes and a two-way left turn lane on a curb and gutter street and a sidewalk on one side and a bicycle sidepath on the other side and intersection modifications at each end. Construction is expected in 2024.
- The **Chadwick Flyer Trail** paralleling N 21st Street in Ozark along the Tracker Marine Road (4,200 feet) Road (4,200 feet) is under design with construction expected in 2024.
- Extension of **South Creek Trail** along Sunset Street from National Avenue to Fremont Street.

Under Design

Springfield

- The **Grant Avenue Parkway Project** is in the design and construction process. The design-build team is continuing design and right-of-way acquisition. Construction is expected through summer 2024. Planning and development efforts are underway to improve the neighborhood on each side of the parkway between Parkview High School and College Street. Grant Avenue from Walnut Street to Sunshine Street will be reconstructed to include a side path on one side, improved 5-foot sidewalk on other side, underground utilities, landscaping, improved lighting, and other features funded by a BUILD Grant. - o The bridge on **Scenic Avenue over Wilson's Creek** will be rebuilt with a walk/bike sidepath in 2024.
- Renew Jordan Creek is a project to bring Jordan Creek out of the culvert into daylight between
 Mill Street, Boonville Avenue, Water Street, and Main Street in an active park setting.
- The bridge on Main Avenue over Jordan Creek will be rebuilt including sidewalk and sidepath on roadway surface.
- Walnut Street bridge over Jordan Creek is to be replaced including provision for trail along Jordan Creek.
- Extension of South Creek Trail along the north side of Meador Park from Fremont Avenue to Battlefield Mall Entrance.
- Jordan Creek Trail connection with 10-foot side path along Sherman Avenue from Jordan Valley Park to Chestnut Expressway.
- Jordan Creek Trail extension through Smith Park to Division Street.
- o **Grand Street** 10-path from Jordan Creek Trail to National Avenue.
- Doling Creek Trail from Doling Park to Norton Road as part of the I-44 construction project.
- The Jefferson Avenue Footbridge over the BNSF Railroad is to be rehabilitated and accessible features added.

Ozark

- The Chadwick Flyer Trail bridge over US Highway 65 in Ozark has been funded with construction expected by 2025.
- o Garrison Springs Trail trailhead and parking lot at East Jackson Street and 6th Avenue.
- Chadwick Flyer Trail Connector along Parkview Street to Ozark High School.

• Little Sac River Basin

- The **Dirt 66 suspension bridge** across the south arm of Fellows Lake connecting Stick Dance Trail and Chandler's Way Trail.
- Two new bridges on Fulbright Spring Trail to replace the locations that the trail fords the river and is often under water in and near Lost Hill Park.
- **Republic** The **Shuyler Creek Trail** (0.63 mile) along Farm Road 182 from State Route ZZ to Matteson Avenue is being designed and right-of-way is being acquired. Construction is expected in 2024.
- Battlefield Trail of Tears Connector along Elm St (FR 182) from Cloverdale Avenue to FR 131.
- Niza Cheyenne Trail along Cheyenne Road and North Road from Summit Elementary School to Cheyenne Valley subdivision

Planning

- The Lake Springfield Master Plan
- The **Chadwick Flyer Trail** design study is underway for the BNSF track between Kissick Road and Sunshine Street. Negotiations are underway with BNSF to vacate that railroad to Ozark Greenways or City of Springfield.
